

[Eph 1:15](#) -23 15 For this reason I too, having heard of the faith in the Lord Jesus which exists among you and your love for all the saints,  
16 do not cease giving thanks for you, while making mention of you in my prayers;  
17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him.  
18 I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,  
19 and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe. These are in accordance with the working of the strength of His might  
20 which He brought about in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places,  
21 far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come.  
22 And He put all things in subjection under His feet, and gave Him as head over all things to the church,  
23 which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.

[Ephesia ns 3:14](#) -21 14 For this reason I bow my knees before the Father,  
15 from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name,  
16 that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man,  
17 so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; and that you, being rooted and grounded in love,  
18 may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth,  
19 and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled up to all the fullness of God.  
20 Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us,  
21 to Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen.

[Ephesia ns 5:20](#) -20 18 With all prayer and petition pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be on the alert with all perseverance and petition for all the saints,  
19 and pray on my behalf, that utterance may be given to me in the opening of my mouth, to make known with boldness the mystery of the gospel,  
20 for which I am an ambassador in chains; that in proclaiming it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

[Phil 1:9](#) -11 9 And this I pray, that your love may abound still more and more in real knowledge and all discernment,  
10 so that you may approve the things that are excellent, in order to be sincere and blameless until the day of Christ;  
11 having been filled with the fruit of righteousness which comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

[Col 1:3](#) We give thanks to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you,  
[Col 1:9](#) -12 9 For this reason also, since the day we heard of it, we have not ceased to pray for you and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding,  
10 so that you will walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please Him in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;  
11 strengthened with all power, according to His glorious might, for the attaining of all steadfastness and patience; joyously  
12 giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in Light.

[Colossia ns 3:17](#) Whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father.  
[Col 4:2](#) -3 2 Devote yourselves to prayer, keeping alert in it with an attitude of thanksgiving;  
3 praying at the same time for us as well, that God will open up to us a door for the word, so that we may speak forth the mystery of Christ, for which I have also been imprisoned;  
2 We give thanks to God always for all of you, making mention of you in our prayers;  
1 [Thessala nians 1:2](#) -5 3 constantly bearing in mind your work of faith and labor of love and steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ in the presence of our God and Father,

5 for our gospel did not come to you in word only, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction; just as you know what kind of men we proved to be among you for your sake.

10 as we night and day keep praying most earnestly that we may see your face, and may complete what is lacking in your faith?  
11 Now may our God and Father Himself and Jesus our Lord direct our way to you;  
12 and may the Lord cause you to increase and abound in love for one another, and for all people, just as we also do for you;  
13 so that He may establish your hearts without blame in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus with all His saints.

17 pray without ceasing;  
18 in everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

2 We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brethren, as is *only* fitting, because your faith is greatly enlarged, and the love of each one of you toward one another grows *ever* greater;

[2 Thess 1:11 - 12](#) 11 To this end also we pray for you always, that our God will count you worthy of your calling, and fulfill every desire for goodness and the work of faith with power,  
 12 so that the name of our Lord Jesus will be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.

2 But we should always give thanks to God for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God has chosen you from the beginning for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and faith in the truth.

[Philem 4 - 6](#) 4 I thank my God always, making mention of you in my prayers,  
 5 because I hear of your love and of the faith which you have toward the Lord Jesus and toward all the saints;  
 6 and I pray that the fellowship of your faith may become effective through the knowledge of every good thing which is in you for Christ's sake.

[Hebrews 13:15](#) Through Him then, let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that give thanks to His name.

[Heb 13:18 - 19](#) 18 Pray for us, for we are sure that we have a good conscience, desiring to conduct ourselves honorably in all things.  
 19 And I urge you all the more to do this, so that I may be restored to you the sooner.

 5 But if any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all generously and without reproach, and it will be given to him.  
 6 But he must ask in faith without any doubting, for the one who doubts is like the surf of the sea, driven and tossed by the wind.  
 7 For that man ought not to expect that he will receive anything from the Lord,  
 8 being a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.

[James 4:2](#) You lust and do not have; *so* you commit murder. You are envious and cannot obtain; *so* you fight and quarrel. You do not have because you do not ask.  
[James 4:3](#) You ask and do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, so that you may spend *it* on your pleasures.  
[James 5:13](#) Is anyone among you suffering? Then he must [pray](#). Is anyone cheerful? He is to sing praises.  
[James 5:14](#) Is anyone among you sick? Then he must call for the elders of the church and they are to [pray](#) over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord;  
[James 5:15](#) and the prayer offered in faith will restore the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up, and if he has committed sins, they will be forgiven him.  
[James 5:16](#) Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and [pray](#) for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.  
[James 5:17](#) Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he [prayed](#) earnestly that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the earth for three years and six months.  
[1 John 3:22](#) and whatever we ask we receive from Him, because we keep His commandments and do the things that are pleasing in His sight.  
[1 John 5:14](#) This is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.  
[1 John 5:15](#) And if we know that He hears us *in* whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him.
