

Matt 24:1	Καὶ ἐξελθὼν ὁ Ἰησοῦς ἀπὸ τοῦ ἱεροῦ ἐπορεύετο, καὶ προσῆλθον οἱ μαθηταὶ αὐτοῦ ἐπιδειξαι αὐτῷ τὰς οἰκοδομὰς τοῦ ἱεροῦ.	Jesus came out from the temple and was going away when His disciples came up to point out the temple buildings to Him.
Mark 13:1	Καὶ ἐκπορευομένου αὐτοῦ ἐκ τοῦ ἱεροῦ λέγει αὐτῷ εἷς τῶν μαθητῶν αὐτοῦ· διδάσκαλε, ἴδε ποταποὶ λίθοι καὶ ποταπαὶ οἰκοδομαί .	As He was going out of the temple, one of His disciples said to Him, “Teacher, behold what wonderful stones and what wonderful buildings! ”
Mark 13:2	καὶ ὁ Ἰησοῦς εἶπεν αὐτῷ· βλέπεις ταύτας τὰς μεγάλας οἰκοδομὰς ; οὐ μὴ ἀφεθῆ ὧδε λίθος ἐπὶ λίθον ὃς οὐ μὴ καταλυθῆ.	And Jesus said to him, “Do you see these great buildings ? Not one stone will be left upon another which will not be torn down.”
Rom 14:19	Ἔρα οὖν τὰ τῆς εἰρήνης διώκωμεν καὶ τὰ τῆς οἰκοδομῆς τῆς εἰς ἀλλήλους.	So then we pursue the things which make for peace and the building up of one another.
Rom 15:2	ἕκαστος ἡμῶν τῷ πλησίον ἀρεσκέτω εἰς τὸ ἀγαθὸν πρὸς οἰκοδομήν .	Each of us is to please his neighbor for his good, to his edification .
1 Cor 3:9	θεοῦ γάρ ἐσμεν συνεργοί, θεοῦ γεώργιον, θεοῦ οἰκοδομή ἐστε.	For we are God’s fellow workers; you are God’s field, God’s building .
1 Cor 14:3	ὁ δὲ προφητεύων ἀνθρώποις λαλεῖ οἰκοδομήν καὶ παράκλησιν καὶ παραμυθίαν.	But one who prophesies speaks to men for edification and exhortation and consolation.
1 Cor 14:5	θέλω δὲ πάντας ὑμᾶς λαλεῖν γλώσσαις, μᾶλλον δὲ ἵνα προφητεύητε· μείζων δὲ ὁ προφητεύων ἢ ὁ λαλῶν γλώσσαις ἐκτὸς εἰ μὴ διερμηνεύη, ἵνα ἡ ἐκκλησία οἰκοδομήν λάβῃ.	Now I wish that you all spoke in tongues, but <i>even</i> more that you would prophesy; and greater is one who prophesies than one who speaks in tongues, unless he interprets, so that the church may receive edifying .
1 Cor 14:12	οὕτως καὶ ὑμεῖς, ἐπεὶ ζηλωταὶ ἐστε πνευμάτων, πρὸς τὴν οἰκοδομήν τῆς ἐκκλησίας ζητεῖτε ἵνα περισσεύητε.	So also you, since you are zealous of spiritual <i>gifts</i> , seek to abound for the edification of the church.
1 Cor 14:26	τί οὖν ἐστίν, ἀδελφοί; ὅταν συνέρχησθε, ἕκαστος ψαλμὸν ἔχει, διδαχὴν ἔχει, ἀποκάλυψιν ἔχει, γλῶσσαν ἔχει, ἐρμηνείαν ἔχει· πάντα πρὸς οἰκοδομήν γινέσθω.	What is <i>the outcome</i> then, brethren? When you assemble, each one has a psalm, has a teaching, has a revelation, has a tongue, has an interpretation. Let all things be done for edification .
2 Cor 5:1	οἶδαμεν γάρ ὅτι ἐὰν ἡ ἐπίγειος ἡμῶν οἰκία τοῦ σκηνοῦ καταλυθῆ, οἰκοδομήν ἐκ θεοῦ ἔχομεν, οἰκίαν ἀχειροποίητον αἰώνιον ἐν τοῖς οὐρανοῖς.	For we know that if the earthly tent which is our house is torn down, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.

<p>2 Cor 10:8 ἐάν [τε] γὰρ περισσώτερόν τι καυχῆσωμαι περὶ τῆς ἐξουσίας ἡμῶν ἢς ἔδωκεν ὁ κύριος εἰς οἰκοδομήν καὶ οὐκ εἰς καθαίρεισιν ὑμῶν, οὐκ αἰσχυνθήσομαι.</p>	<p>For even if I boast somewhat further about our authority, which the Lord gave for building you up and not for destroying you, I will not be put to shame,</p>
<p>2 Cor 12:19 Πάλαι δοκεῖτε ὅτι ὑμῖν ἀπολογούμεθα. κατέναντι θεοῦ ἐν Χριστῷ λαλοῦμεν· τὰ δὲ πάντα, ἀγαπητοί, ὑπὲρ τῆς ὑμῶν οἰκοδομῆς.</p>	<p>All this time you have been thinking that we are defending ourselves to you. <i>Actually</i>, it is in the sight of God that we have been speaking in Christ; and all for your upbuilding, beloved.</p>
<p>2 Cor 13:10 Διὰ τοῦτο ταῦτα ἀπὼν γράφω, ἵνα παρὼν μὴ ἀποτόμως χρήσωμαι κατὰ τὴν ἐξουσίαν ἣν ὁ κύριος ἔδωκεν μοι εἰς οἰκοδομήν καὶ οὐκ εἰς καθαίρεισιν.</p>	<p>For this reason I am writing these things while absent, so that when present I <i>need</i> not use severity, in accordance with the authority which the Lord gave me for building up and not for tearing down.</p>
<p>Eph 2:21 ἐν ᾧ πᾶσα οἰκοδομῆ συναρμολογουμένη αὖξει εἰς ναὸν ἅγιον ἐν κυρίῳ,</p>	<p>in whom the whole building, being fitted together, is growing into a holy temple in the Lord,</p>
<p>Eph 4:12 πρὸς τὸν καταρτισμὸν τῶν ἁγίων εἰς ἔργον διακονίας, εἰς οἰκοδομήν τοῦ σώματος τοῦ Χριστοῦ,</p>	<p>for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ;</p>
<p>Eph 4:16 ἐξ οὗ πᾶν τὸ σῶμα συναρμολογούμενον καὶ συμβιβαζόμενον διὰ πάσης ἀφῆς τῆς ἐπιχορηγίας κατ' ἐνέργειαν ἐν μέτρῳ ἐνὸς ἐκάστου μέρους τὴν αὖξιν τοῦ σώματος ποιεῖται εἰς οἰκοδομήν ἑαυτοῦ ἐν ἀγάπῃ.</p>	<p>from whom the whole body, being fitted and held together by what every joint supplies, according to the proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love.</p>
<p>Eph 4:29 πᾶς λόγος σαπρὸς ἐκ τοῦ στόματος ὑμῶν μὴ ἐκπορευέσθω, ἀλλὰ εἴ τις ἀγαθὸς πρὸς οἰκοδομήν τῆς χρείας, ἵνα δῶ χάριν τοῖς ἀκούουσιν.</p>	<p>Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such <i>a word</i> as is good for edification according to the need <i>of the moment</i>, so that it will give grace to those who hear.</p>
